

Supervision During a Use of Force Event

Course Description: This course is designed for LEO, Corrections, Detention, and various Security professionals to understand their role in the Use of Force process. Participants will learn the fundamentals of supervision, critical decision-making concepts during a Use of Force event, and communication throughout the event. A progression of concepts and techniques will be presented in a manner as to ensure that the concepts are fully understood prior to exposure to the next. The participant will learn techniques to increase their own self-control in order to provide leadership to those who are using force and to the subject as well.

Participant requirements: The participant should be a certified instructor, a shift supervisor, or a key staff member that leads and trains other staff members for their agency. Participants are expected to participate in scenario-based training. It is up to the participant to know what their physical limitations are and be honest with themselves and the instructors if there is any specific area of concern that should be considered. This class is physically demanding, and every effort will be made to prevent injury.

This is a 20-hour course, split into 2 (10) hour days. All equipment/lesson plans are provided for you, to include a manual to take home/refresh yourself and your agency's staff members. PACEM will also provide you a USB pen with all UOF documentation.

Class will begin each morning at 7am.

Attire required is business casual (khakis/bdu's – polo shirts – closed toe shoes)
